Zero Tolerance Offense (Admin Referral)	1st Occurrence		2nd Occurrence	Students on OSS are not permitted on school grounds, or at any school functions at school or away, and are ineligible for school activities during their suspension. To do so will be considered trespassing, an arrestable offense.
Arson; Bomb threat (tracing equipment is in place at all schools); False fire alarm; Burglary, robbery and/or theft (felony), as related to school property, are violations on a year-round basis; Malicious Destruction and/or Defacing of School Property (Felony Vandalism), as related to school property, are violations on a year-round basis; Assault/Battery; Written/verbal threat and/or Physical Attack of any staff member; Possession/use/distribution/sale of drugs or drug paraphernalia including all controlled substances, look-alikes, alcohol beverages; Possession/use/distribution of a weapon, ammunition, explosive or look-alike devices of any kind.	5 to 10 Days OSS, Possible Arrest The administration may impose a required 10 day suspension. The discretion may be exercised based on the student's past disciplinary record and significant variables of the case.
